 - 1L RSVP for PASS is low (currently only 26 have signed up, last year 100 1Ls signed up) → maybe still too early, some might not officially RSVP but will attend anyways, perhaps in-person instruction means less 1Ls have questions?
 - Could 1L reps get some intel on how the 1Ls are doing and why they might not want to attend PASS?
 - Could 1L reps promote PASS? (I will also post reminder post on Facebook on Monday + reach out to Inna about an instagram story for Monday)
 - Apparently many profs were concerned about students copy and pasting into Exam4 and this was affecting their choice of which mode to run exams on and didn't know it wasn't possible to copy/paste on exam4. so I contacted vice Dean to send out a communication to all instructors that you can't copy and paste into exam4 so everyone's on the same page.

- VP Services
 - 1L photos last week not successful students would like more notice to prepare for photos
 - Photo session to come; still have to figure out times that we can do this (potentially between 1L classes during the weekday?)
 - Discussion: Challenges re: communication to the whole student body. FB seems
 to be the most "engaged" space, but the problem of putting things on FB is that
 we don't reach the entire student body and we don't want to force people to use
 a SM platform. (Was a concern from previous VP Serv.) Problem has become
 impairment to some of the work happening (e.g. consent forms for WW, general
 student outreach).
 - VP Services to coordinate with VP External on Calendar
 - Consent forms for WW: Some concerns raised to me about having implied consent and opt out instead of actual consent for Who's Who inclusion
 - We only have 209 responses so far, but I don't want to open us to potential backlash pivoting the response form to implied consent
 - Connected to issue of email outreach; not enough people read our emails
 - Request: more streamlined calendar for LSA as a whole to access (e.g. Google Calendar) where we can put in student/faculty events that are happening
 - Challenges with email campaigns: need direct student emails. Currently our
 emails go out through the faculty's email groupings based on year. Not sure if we
 would be allowed to have access to individual student emails or if it might be a no
 from student services to follow up on.
